Match Report

As usual, Ossy Muskwe gained the team valuable points whilst several athletes who were not 100% due to recent illnesses ran valiantly for crucial points throughout the day. U17 Joe Finch jumped an 10cm pb in the HJ to win the B string with 1.70m. U20 Stuart Ferguson ran a steady first half of the 3000m Steeplechase only to significantly pick up the pace in the second half to catch up over 50m to win in a pb time of 10.34.71. Not to be outdone by their younger counterparts masters athlete Chris

Franks produced several seasons bests in both hammer and shot and Brian Taylor ran a seasons best in his 400m, despite the windy conditions.
