Match Report

With over a dozen athletes unavailable for this match this was always going to be a tough one!

Just 11 Athletes made the trip to Yeovil.

Fellow multi-eventer Osman Muskwe also had a good day with a pb in the Discus (36.90m) creeping ever closer to that elusive club record. He also had an unprecedented win the 100h, equalling his pb of 17.0.

U17 Julian Davies made his mens league debut for valuable points in the middle distances races and masters athletes, Dan New, Phil Davies, Alistair Duncan, Chris Franks and Brian Taylor all worked hard for the team and amassed important points.

Overall the efforts of the team were not enough to come away with a win against an exceptionally strong Yeovil team but the valiant efforts of the athletes who went meant that enough points were amassed to keep Radley in Top spot in the league but just by the skin of their teeth. With one match to go and with the top 3 team fighting it out in the final match it will be a crucial match and this blip in Radley's unbeaten record to date may cost them dearly.
