Match Report

Radley men's team had a superb start to the 2011 track season with a win in their first ever match in Division 2.

The day was dominated by the long jumpers. Multi eventer Ossy Muskwe smashed his own LJ CR by nearly 20cm to jump a massive 6.87m. B string Dan Johnson also leapt to a huge pb to register 6.40m and U17 Jordan Dorrian equalled the U17 CR of 6.10m.

Ossy then went on to gain club records in 2 other events (Javelin-55.51m and TJ-14.37m) as well as equalling his own HJ CR of 1.95m. He finished the day with a pb in the Discus (36.66m) and ran a storming leg in the 4 x 400m.

U20 Ed O'Hara ran a U20 CR in the 400H (61.19) and the sprinters broke the 6 year old 4 x 100m CR in clocking 44.75.

A superb day of athletic and some outstanding performances but more important was the usual excellent team spirit with many athletes covering events they would not normally do to gain valuable points which won us the match!
