### Match Report

This second SML match of the season brought local rivals Radley and Oxford together in their first ever head to head. The match was close throughout the day with just a few points separating the teams and the match could have been won or lost on the final event of the day (the 4 x 400m relay).

Fortunately Radley had put together a great team of Davis Olusile, Osman Muskwe, Jack Humphreys and Henry Tufnell and not only did they win the race by a big margin but broke the CR which has stood since 2004 in the process. They clocked 3.31.7. Definitely a highlight to the day and a great way to seal the win (by an overall points margin of just 2.5 points).

Other great performances of the day came from Stuart Ferguson who had a busy day competing in (and winning) the 800m, 1500m and 3000m steeplechase to amass valuable points for the team. Multi-eventer Osman Muskwe also had a busy day and despite a shoulder injury which forced him to throw 20m under par in javelin and withdraw from the discus amassed 3 wins and 2 second place and ran the anchor leg in the 4 x 400m relay.

Hurdler Corey Brooks ran his first 400mH race of the season and did well to get a 2<sup>nd</sup> place, clocking 68.2 and also debuted in the 110mH for another second place. Master Phil Davies also ran a super 3000m Steeple chase knocking almost 20s off his previous time to clock 13.24.9.

Newcomers to the team also performed well, David Olusile won the 400m in style (52.3) and ran a great leg in the winning 4 x 400m team and Dan Peace ran a good 5K to top the 2011 Club rankings. First year U17 Chris Hewitt also made his debut in the men's team and won the B string 1500m in a pb of 4.27.8.

Overall an amazing day of athletics, some great individual performances but more importantly a superb team performance and a great win which has moved the Radley team up to 2nd in the league, just 4 points behind leaders Basingstoke.
